Classroom Management Plan

Welcome to Kindergarten! The coming year will be an exciting growth experience. In order to provide quality instruction for all children and to encourage appropriate behavior, the following classroom rules are in effect:

1. Respect fellow members of God's family.  
*If God so loved us, we ought to love one another. I John 4:11*
2. Raise your hand and wait to be called on.  
*Live in peace. II Corinthians 13:11*
3. Keep hands, feet, and objects to yourself.  
*Be kind to one another. Eph. 4:32*

The following steps will be taken after violations of the rules:

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| Step 1 | Verbal reminder of appropriate behavior.  |
| Step 2 | Child will be taken aside for private discussion.   |
| Step 3 | Child will sit a short ways away from the rest of the class for 3-4 minutes to recall appropriate behavior and then discuss with teacher. |
| Step 4 | The matter will be discussed with Mr. Rademan and parents will be contacted.  |

Any violent or destructive behavior will result in immediate removal from the rest of the class or to talk with Mr. Rademan. A phone call or email home will occur.

Persistent inappropriate behavior will require a conversation between parent and teacher to work out a solution.

Children will start each day with a "clean slate" and will also receive affirmation for God-pleasing behaviors.
