Dear John and Sarah,

Grace and peace to you. We are all called by Jesus to the Great Commission of Acts 1:8. What a blessing it is to see God at work reaching out to people all over the world through His ministries at First Presbyterian!

In response to this, I feel called to participate on a mission team that will travel to Barahona, Dominican Republic, July 10 – 17 to fulfill His mission for us there. We will do construction work with a local church, conduct a baseball mission camp, offer Vacation Bible School for children, lead a Women’s Bible study, and do health outreach as well as evangelism.
