



Health Classroom Management Plan

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Organize Physical Space

- **Room Arrangement**

- Students will be arranged in single desks spread apart from each other. If desks are not provided, but tables are, students will sit at a table with one other person. Seating arrangements will change every month.



- **Displaying Content**

- Content will be displayed by means of PowerPoint, text book readings, articles, movies, video clips, guest speakers, lecture, role playing, and web quests.

Managing Student Behavior

- **Positive Reinforcement**

- Special rewards will be given to the class if they accomplish a certain task at the level stated during the class.
 - **Example** - Entire class has an average score of about 90% on a test or assignment = class will receive a free homework pass good for one homework assignment. The assignment will receive a perfect score but the student will not have to complete it. Passes can only be used for certain assignments designated by the teacher ahead of time. If not used by the end of the grading period, it can be turned in for 5 points extra credit.

- **Zero-tolerance for Inappropriate Behavior**

- If a student displays inappropriate behavior during class the student will receive one verbal warning. Any display of inappropriate behavior after the first verbal

warning will result in the student losing 5 points for the day. After 3 counts of inappropriate behavior, the student will receive a ZERO for the day.

- If the student continues to display inappropriate behavior daily, the student parents/legal guardian will be contacted.
- If inappropriate behavior shown when a guest speaker is presenting, the student will be sent directly to the office and receive a ZERO for the day.

- **Classroom Rules**

- Always be on time for class, don't be tardy.
- Respects yourself and others, including all adults.
- Respect the property of others.
- Always be prepared for class (books, homework, etc.)
- Follow the directions given the first time and pay attention at all times.

Classroom Procedures

- **Homework**

- Homework assignments will be given throughout the grading period. Homework due dates and requirements will be explained on the day the homework was given.
- Homework that is late will receive a 10% deduction off the overall grade of the homework assignment every day it is late.

- **Classroom Discussion**

- Students will be required to participate in classroom discussion. When working in groups, the students will be required to share equal effort.
- Participation points will be rewarded on selected days of classroom discussion.

- **Tardy/Late Policy**

- Students will be allowed two free tardy passes. After the student has used his/her tardy passes, he/she will report to the office and receive a late pass to enter the classroom.

- **Bathroom/Hall Pass**

- Students will be required to use the bathroom and get drinks between passing periods.

- Students will be given two bathroom passes that they will be able to use during the semester. After the students have used their two passes, they will not be permitted to use the bathroom/drinking fountain unless it is an emergency.
- **Turning in Student Work**
 - Students will be required to have homework and assignments done and ready to turn in upon entering class.
 - Students that fail to have work completed upon enter the classroom will be issued a late and be deducted 10% on the assignment for every day late.

Special Events

- **Field Trips**
 - Parent permission forms will be required to be turned in by the day of the field trip. Failing to have a signed parent permission form will result in the student not going, and be given an alternative assignment to do.
 - Students will be required to abide by the school dress code when attending field trips and are expected to follow the classroom rules.
- **School Assemblies**
 - Students will be required to sit as a class at school assemblies
 - Students that misbehave at the assembly will be taken and have to sit with the teacher for the remainder of the assembly.

Substitute Teacher File

When I am unable to attend class for the day, I will have a substitute teacher file that the teacher will be able to follow regarding the classroom procedures for the day. The students will be required to use the same classroom behavior and the substitute will note if any of the student misbehave. Just because I am not in the classroom does not mean the students have a day off of health education.

Standard Recognition

The three standards that I will incorporate most into my lessons are standards 3, 7, and 8. These standards will be mostly incorporated because it allows the students to show their potential and requires them to engage outside the class room to enhance their health behavior.
